Remote Desktop Manager 2020.1 includes more than 150 additions, enhancements and fixes. Here are some of the key NEW features and functions:

- Connect to RDP and web entries through a secure gateway ([learn more here](#))
- Generate private keys (multi-key type support)
- Support for Azure KeyVault credential type
- Record sessions (Apple Remote Desktop, RDP Configured, SSH Shell, VNC, Wayk Now, and web browser) and save them in files that are directly accessible in Devolutions Password Server (DPS)
- Virtual desktop open destination
- Keep “My Personal Credentials” in memory
