About the Survey

This is the third year in a row that we are asking IT professionals around the world to share their experiences and insights on key topics including:

- 72% of SMBs are more concerned about cybersecurity now compared to a year ago.
- The 3 cyberthreats that SMBs are most concerned about are: ransomware, phishing, and malware.
- 52% of SMBs have experienced a cyberattack in the last year — and 10% have experienced more than 10 cyberattacks.
- Just 13% of SMBs have a fully deployed PAM solution in place.

How have things changed this year, and what do IT professionals predict for the road ahead? The Report will dive into the details and paint a realistic picture of what's really happening on the IT security landscape: the good, the bad, and the ugly.
