What's New

Here's a brief look at some of the **improvements and** additions in RDM for Android 3.0:

- Added session types: FTP (can only open not edit), FTP Native, WebDav, Intel AMT and Devolutions Proxy
- Added support for remote tools
- SQL Server data source: added support for Google Authenticator Two-Factor and custom login
- Added support for data source repositories: SQL Server and DVLS
- Added the quick Connection option. With this option, users can now connect to sessions of type RDP, VNC, Web Browser and SSH Shell without having to create an entry
- Can now Import, Export, Duplicate and manage the cache for data sources
- Support for role based security
- Added RoyalTS support for DropBox Data source
