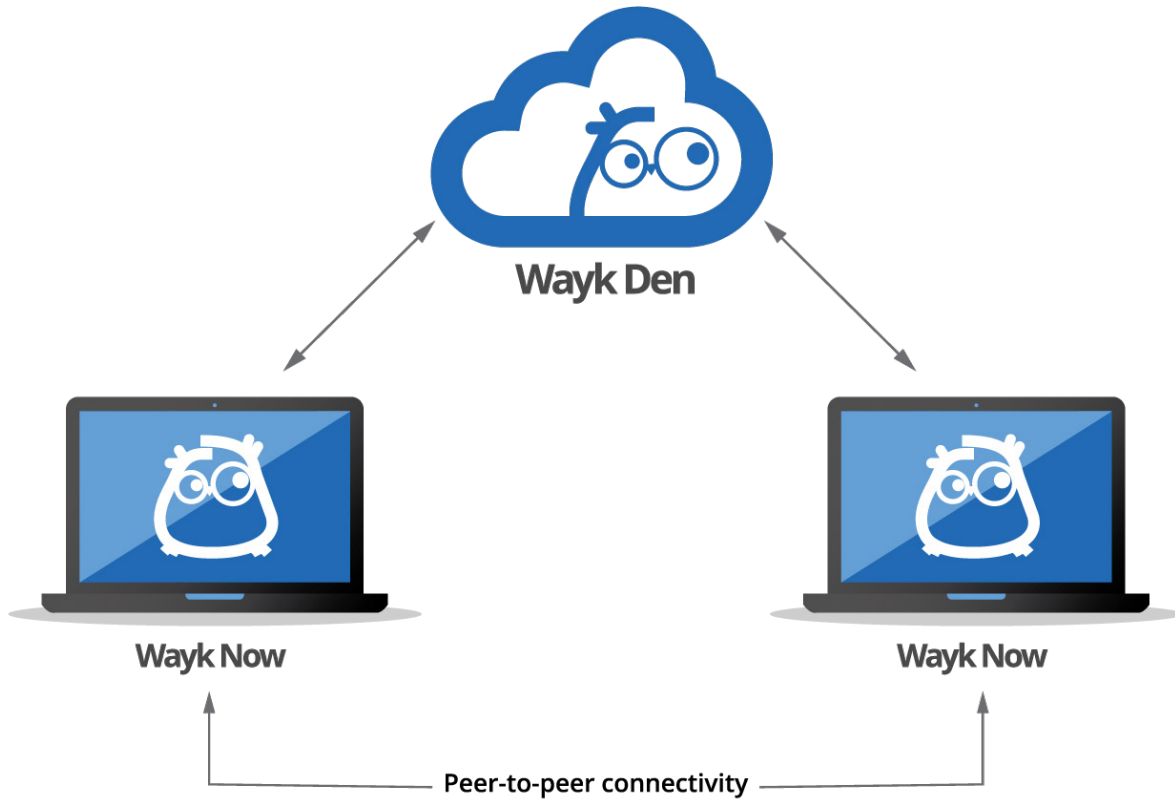

Wayk Den is a cloud service that supports peer-to-peer connectivity over the Internet, enabling you to access a remote computer outside of your network. Think of it like a friendly telephone operator who takes your call and then connects you to the number (i.e. computer) you wish to contact.



If you haven't downloaded Wayk Now yet, then give it a try — you'll probably love it as much as I do. Wayk Now is **free** (and always will be) for personal use, and it's also **free** for commercial purposes.

What's Ahead

By the end of summer Wayk Now will be even more awesome because we'll be releasing an on-premise (self-hosted) edition, which you can install within your network perimeter or behind your firewall. You'll be able to launch peer-to-peer remote sessions across your local or routable networks, or cross-network by bridging through Wayk Den. Stay tuned!
